Bountiful City Reports - 2022 Successes

At the annual City Council retreat in January, staff reported on their department successes in 2022. Included on the list were:



- Progress on Eagle Ridge Drive
- Progress on Washington Park
- 800 East storm drain project
- Awarded the Government Finance Officers Association's (GFOA) award for the 41st consecutive year
- Managing park and golf course maintenance during a restrictive water year

- City take over of recycling pick up
- Over 1,000 court cases handled by the prosecutor's office and 320 victims assisted
- Farmer's Market management with over 100 vendors throughout the summer
- Creation of a short-term rental ordinance
- Accreditation of the Bountiful Police Department by the Utah Chiefs of Police Association
- Close monitoring of power sources saving millions of dollars
- Grants and private funding received for trail projects
- Distinguished Budget Award from the GFOA for seven consecutive years
- Six newsletters per year instead of four to keep residents informed
