General Plan Update

What is a "General Plan"?

The State of Utah requires every county and municipality to "prepare and adopt a comprehensive, long-range plan" in order to "provide for the health, safety, and welfare" of each municipality and its residents. (UCA 10-9a-401) Bountiful's General Plan outlines City goals, objectives and guiding policies as they pertain to overall direction for the City.

We have begun updating our General Plan to help provide direction and guidance regarding future land use, housing, transportation, sustainability and smart growth, economic development, stewardship of resources and various other possible elements.

How often is the General Plan updated?

There is no set time frame to update a General Plan.

What is the process to update the General Plan?

There are four phases involved in updating the General Plan (Foundation & Research; Community Outreach & Engagement; Document Production and Review; Plan Adoption) with the fourth phase (adoption) scheduled to be completed in June of 2023.

When was the General Plan last updated?

The last General Plan update was done in 2009.

Why should Bountiful residents get involved?

The General Plan describes where residents are, where they want to be, and how they will get there by outlining the City's priorities and intentions for the future.

How do I get involved?

Several public meetings will be held over the next 14 months and will be noticed on our website, posted on our social media (Facebook, Instagram and/or Twitter) and in our twice-a-month E-Newsletter.
