he bond posted with the building permit will be returned after an inspection by Bountiful 7 no sooner than one year after occupancy is granted for the house. The cash bond will be rned to the current owner of the property, at the time the deposit is determined to be tible for release.			
verify the condition of the street, sidewalk, driveway approach, curb and gutter improvements or to construction, the permittee shall submit to the City Engineer photographs showing the rovements and any condition issues in such detail as to verify any preexisting conditions. tos must be received prior to the permit being issued.
