## Winter Parking Ordinance in Effect!

Overnight parking on Bountiful City streets is prohibited between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1 through March 31, so our awesome snow plow drivers (see picture above) can safely and efficiently clean our streets!



Also, please do not shovel or blow snow from your property into plowed streets - it is unlawful\*, not safe and defeats the work of the plow drivers! For more information, visit our website!

Crews will also be picking up leaves until the snow flies. If possible, please bag your leaves and leave them on the curb for pickup.

## Winter 2025 CERT Basic Course

Sign up now for the Winter 2025 CERT Basic Course, which will be held weekly on Wednesday evenings starting January 22 and ending March 12. The mock disaster will be on Saturday, March 15 at the Bountiful Police firing range. Having this knowledge and training is invaluable during an emergency in our community.

Classes will be held at Fire Station #81, 255 South 100 West, from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. Topics include disaster awareness, basic medical skills, life saving skills, emergency communications, and more.

## Questions about Bountiful Fiber?



Crews are making great progress on installing conduit for fiber in Bountiful City. You've no doubt seen them either in your neighborhood or around town.

The City is divided into ten "footprints" for rolling out Bountiful Fiber service! So far, there is availability in footprints two and three and parts of one, five and seven. These footprints are mostly in the northwest/west part of the City.

Notices are posted on our website and social media as residents in more areas of the City can sign up for Bountiful Fiber service so be sure to follow us there!
